Pharmacy Technician International Evaluation Portfolio Assessment Candidate Declaration of Professional Integrity

Healthcare professionals, including pharmacy technicians, are expected to abide by a code of ethics to guide their behaviour to ensure that they act with the highest standards of integrity and professionalism so that the public can maintain its confidence and trust in the profession. PEBC, and the profession of pharmacy, expects this level of conduct even at the earliest stages of entering into a profession, such as when candidates are seeking to enter the pathway to licensure and registration into the profession through the Pharmacy Technician International Evaluation Process.

PEBC requires that candidates read, understand and abide by the declaration statements below. As a part of the review of the Portfolio Assessment, PEBC reserves the right to verify the information provided, as well as require the candidate to undertake a follow-up interview to satisfy PEBC that the contents of the portfolio reflect the candidate's own lived experience. If it is determined by PEBC that the candidate breached this Declaration of Professional Integrity, it reserves the right to:

- cancel the result of the International Evaluation;
- prevent future access to PEBC's assessment;
- notify professional regulatory or educational bodies, as appropriate; and
- apply any other consequences as stipulated in the declaration statements on the Pharmacy Technician International Evaluation application form.
