ERRORS AND OMISSIONS IN PREPARED BLISTER- PACK (examples of some types that may be included):

Drug A – ordered q 12 h, scheduled for AM (6 am) and HS (10 pm)

- MAR incorrect directions should be q 12 h (not bid) and scheduled for 6 AM and 6 PM (not 6 am and 10 pm)
- Blister-pack incorrect should have capsules in the 6 PM slots, all 7 days; should not have

capsules in the *10 PM* slots (both time slots have errors) **Drug B** – ordered TID, correctly scheduled for AM (6 am), noon (12) and supper (6 pm)

- MAR correct
- Blister-pack incorrect no tablet in AM dose slot on Tuesday
